WELCOME AND OVERVIEW

We cordially invite you to join the Indian Creek Recreation Club (ICRC) for our 2011 season. This year's information packet is longer than in the past to provide potential members with a more comprehensive overview of what will be offered in the coming months. The Pool Facility will open on Saturday May 28, 2011 and our annual Open House (for members and non-members) and Anything That Floats race is expected to take place on Sunday, May 29, 2011.

The ICRC is pleased and excited to announce membership rates will remain the same AGAIN this year despite the lull in the economy. We value your friendship and commitment to the Indian Creek pool and want to continue this as a place your family makes memories. If you know someone who is considering joining a pool, please recommend the Indian Creek pool to them. You will receive up to a **\$50 referral bonus** for each referral. Please note that all new members will be required to pay a one-time initiation fee. If you are not sure whether you have paid this in the past, please contact Karla Brenneman, Treasurer at karlabrenneman@gmail.com. Short-term Renters who live in Indian Creek and Sleepy Hollow are not required to pay the initiation fee. In addition, the ICRC will be honoring seniors (at least 55 years) and ACTIVE military personnel with a **20 percent discount** off the membership price of their choosing.

Residents of Indian Creek and Sleepy Hollow may not come as guests of members. Please consider investing in your community like your neighbors and friends have. Members may bring guests living outside the neighborhood for \$5 per day (age 2 and under free). Guest passes may be purchased in books of 10 for \$40.

Many activities, events, and parties planned for the 2011 season are contingent upon volunteers within the member community and are expected to include tween nights, teen nights, family dive-in movies, holiday parties and other social events. In addition, the ICRC will be offering swim lessons and tennis lessons as well as an opportunity to join the Indian Creek Aquatic Club (swim team) to both members and non-members of the ICRC facility. 2011 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

THE ICRC IS OFFERING INCENTIVES FOR NEW REFERRALS!

- Refer a **NEW** member for a **FAMILY** Membership and receive a **\$50 Referral Bonus**. The referral will not apply to pro-rated memberships (available after July 15th). The referral bonus will only be awarded to one family. *The referring family must also submit the name of the family they are referring to the Membership Secretary, Michelle Moore, prior to the new member joining.* If a referral is made by more than one family, the bonus will be awarded to the family whose application is received first.
- Refer a **NEW** member for **ADULT, SINGLE HEAD-OF-HOUSEHOLD** or **SOCIAL** Membership and receive a **\$25 Referral Bonus**.

DISCOUNTS (20%) ARE AVAILABLE FOR SENIORS AND MILITARY PERSONNEL!

The Indian Creek Recreation Club is offering seniors and military personnel **20 percent off** any membership type. The discount should be applied to the early bird price, if the application is received on or before April 30, 2011. Otherwise, the discount should be applied to the post-April 30, 2011 price. The discount should not be applied to either the Community Service Fee or the Initiation Fee. Members who may qualify as both seniors and military may only qualify for ONE 20 percent discount.

- Senior Discount: Discount is valid for adults who are at least 55 years of age by April 30, 2011. Please include a photocopy of your driver's license or other identification card with your application.
- Military Discount: Discount is valid for ACTIVE persons. Please include a photocopy of your military identification card with your application.

MEMBERSHIP DETAILS

All members are required to pay the community service fee (\$48) annually and are required to pay the initiation fee (\$200) during the first year of membership. A brief description of each membership type and community service fee requirements are presented below.

- **FAMILY:** Membership includes two adults and all children living at home or grandchildren when no children are living at home (minimum of three people). Families with only one child, two years of age or younger, qualify for either Single head-of-household or an Adult membership as children under 2 years of age are free and are not included in the family count.
- **SINGLE HEAD-OF-HOUSEHOLD:** Membership includes one adult at home with dependent children.
- **ADULT:** Membership applies to homes with no children under age 19. Up to two resident adults will be accepted.
- **SOCIAL:** Membership includes 15 total pool passes, which may be used for any ICRC sponsored activity.

Extra Options:

- **BABYSITTER PLAN:** Members who purchase this plan may employ non-member babysitters to watch their children at the pool. Limited to ONE babysitter at any given time.
- **SWIM LESSONS:** Swim lessons will be offered to members and non-members ages (3 and up). Group lessons and private lessons are available.
- **TENNIS KEY:** A non-refundable fee to gain entry to the tennis courts. If you purchase a key, you will receive an email on the date and place for key pick-up.

Initiation Fee:

All new members are required to pay a one-time initiation fee. If you are not sure whether you have paid this in the past, please contact Karla Brenneman, Treasurer at karlabrenneman@gmail.com. Short-term Renters who live in Indian Creek and Sleepy Hollow are not required to pay the initiation fee.

2011 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Community Service Fee (CSF):

In order to keep costs down and to encourage participation and pride-of-ownership, ICRC requires an adult within each membership category to volunteer for **six (6) hours** during the season. A \$48 CSF will be added to each membership total. If you fulfill your 6 hours of service, the \$48 will be refunded to you at the close of the pool season (following Fall Bonfire). You may “opt out” and choose to pay the CSF, which will not be refunded, and you will not be contacted to volunteer. Community service options are listed on the following page. 2011 SUMMER SWIMMING LESSONS FORM

The Indian Creek Recreation Club will be offering a **“LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAM”** to **pool members and non-members ages 3 and older**. This program will be taught in a group setting. Swimmers should be able to separate from their parent/guardian for the lessons. Skill appropriate levels will accommodate children through early elementary school (from water comfort to pre-competitive swimmers). Lessons will be held at the Indian Creek pool (at 458 ½ Pawnee Drive in the Indian Creek Development in Hampden Township). Lessons will be taught by certified lifeguards. There will be two to three swimmers per instructor. Instructors will follow a course of skills which will be given to parents of each registered child at the conclusion of the program. All swimmers will be included in a picnic and free swim on the last day of lessons.

“LEARN TO SWIM” Classes will be offered as follows:

- SESSION 1: June 13 – June 17, 2011 (11:30 am to 12:30 pm)
- SESSION 2: June 20 – June 24, 2011 (11:30 am to 12:30 pm)
- SESSION 3: June 20 – June 24, 2011 (6:00 pm to 7:00 pm)
- SESSION 4: August 1 – August 5, 2011 (11:30 am to 12:30 pm)

The Indian Creek Recreation Club will also be offering **PRIVATE SWIM INSTRUCTION** to **pool members and non-members ages 3 and older**. Parents will be required to coordinate with the Pool Manager to set-up private swim lessons at a convenient time for both the lifeguard and the child. Lessons will be taught by certified lifeguards.

The Indian Creek Aquatic Club is a summer swim team, a member of the Capital Area Swim League (CASL), and is open to all area swimmers. Our team philosophy is to promote individual improvement in both stroke technique and event time while having fun during the summer break. With an excellent and stable coaching staff, we have been able to maintain our legacy of excellence and improvement from year to year. With four coaches on staff, our members have more opportunity to receive individual attention in practice sessions.

Swimming with the Indian Creek Aquatic Club provides excellent physical conditioning combined with focused stroke technique development. The coaching staff provides skill appropriate practices for all levels from beginner through advanced. All swimmers must be able to swim one length of the pool (25 meters).

Excellent role models for team members of all ages, our coaching staff provides training and stroke instruction in a fun, controlled, and positive atmosphere.

The team's optional spring training clinic is held indoor at the West Shore YMCA. Summer practices and home swim meets are held in the outdoor pool at the Indian Creek Recreation Club (the "REC Club").
