PRIVATE POOL PARTIES

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All Private Parties, during hours or after hours, must be registered with the Pool Manager at least two weeks in advance of the party.(exceptions may apply based on availability)
- Member host must sign and return this form and Full Payment, as well as the Hold Harmless Release form, at least one week prior to the party to the Pool Manager.
- No Private Parties will be approved during Indian Creek sponsored events.

ALL POOL PARTIES:

- Parties must be hosted by an ICRC member.
- Non ICRC Members living in Indian Creek and Sleepy Hollow may attend registered Private Parties, but may only stay for the scheduled time of the party.
- The grill may be rented for use during the Private Party. A \$15.00 service fee will be charged. An adult must be present and responsible for grilling. Grill usage must be requested at least one week prior to the party.
- Member Host(s) must bring and use their own supplies. (i.e. paper products, condiments, utensils, etc.)
- Member Host(s) are responsible for the actions of their guests at all times, inside and outside of the pool complex, including tennis courts, parking lot, creek side, and picnic areas.
- Set up and clean up is the complete responsibility of the Member Host. An additional \$10 fee will be assessed if any employee or member must clean up trash or items are left. Trash must be placed in the dumpster at the far end of the parking lot. Membership status may be affected if this is not paid within 10 days of the party.
- Guests are not permitted to remain after Member Host leaves and is the responsibility of the Host (s) to ensure. (Not Management/Staff)

DURING POOL HOURS:

- Parties of 26 or more people must be held in the picnic area outside the fence.
- Parties of 25 or less may be held inside the pool complex. Set up must be either on the grassy side of the Snack Shack, on the back side of the baby pool (by the small shed or the garage), or using a maximum of 2 picnic tables.
- Picnic tables may not be moved.
- If available, tables may be borrowed from the garage with the permission and assistance of the Pool Manager/Staff.
- Parties must be cleaned up no later than 7:50 p.m., unless the party is contracted to continue into after hours.

AFTER POOL HOURS:

- Picnic tables may not be moved.
- If available, tables may be borrowed from the garage with the permission and assistance of the Pool Manager/Staff.
- Parties must be cleaned up no later than 10 minutes prior to contracted ending time. The life guards must be paid an additional hour if they must stay beyond the contracted ending time to lock the facilities. The Member Host(s) will be billed for this charge.

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RATES

DURING POOL HOURS:

- Party goers who are members – no additional fee
- Party goers who are nonmembers – guest rates apply. \$5/guest. Groups of ten guest passes may be purchased for \$40. 2 and under are free.
- If additional lifeguards are needed, an additional \$15 per hour per guard fee will be assessed to the Member Host(s).

AFTER POOL HOURS:

- \$100.00 3 hour maximum in pool area (11:00 p.m. complex closing)
- \$15.00 per hour per guard (2 guard minimum per 50 guests)
- Full payment must be received at least 1 week prior to event.
