

# **DIVING WELL PROCEDURE**

## **Effective IMMEDIATELY**

**Swimming in the diving well will only be permitted at certain times of the day.**

Beginning at the end of each adult swim (15 minutes past the hour) Swimming will be permitted in the diving well and the diving board will be closed for 15 minutes each hour. At this time games like sharks and minnows will be permitted in the diving well.

At half past each hour the lifeguards will blow a short whistle to clear the diving well of all swimmers and NO SWIMMER may enter the diving well for the remainder of the hour except from the diving board (the diving board will be open at this time until the end of adult swim).

If a swimmer jumps or dives from the side of the pool, or attempts to swim in the diving well during DIVING BOARD time, the lifeguard will whistle and remind the swimmer of the rule. A second attempt will result in a 5 minute benching. Any further breaking of this rule will warrant a discussion with that child's parents and loss of privilege to attend the pool without parent in attendance.

This procedure is in effect WHETHER OR NOT there are any people in line for the diving board. If no one is interested in diving during the time the dive is open then the diving well will not be in use. NO EXCEPTIONS will be made to this rule during the course of a general pool day.

This procedure is in accordance with the standing RULES and REGULATIONS of the ICRC.
