RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please retain for future reference, as this will not be distributed annually. All questions and/or comments should be made in writing to the attention of the Board of Directors.



The following Rules and Regulations have been established for the Indian Creek Recreation Club (REC CLUB) Members and their guests. Parents are responsible for their children and shall instruct them to observe all rules and obey instructions of the Pool Manager and other pool employees.

1. Bikes must be kept outside pool fence and away from entrance gate.
2. ALL MEMBERS MUST SIGN IN DAILY AT THE POOL ENTRANCE. Please enter the grounds through the main entrance.
3. GUESTS:
 - a. **ANY RESIDENT OF INDIAN CREEK/SLEEPY HOLLOW WHO IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE REC CLUB MAY NOT BE ADMITTED AS A GUEST without the expressed written permission from the REC CLUB Board of Directors.**
 - b. All guests must be accompanied by a current Member in good standing and must sign in on the guest register.
 - c. Members are responsible for seeing that their guests abide by the rules and regulations of the REC CLUB.
 - d. Guests will be charged the following rates per day: \$5/day at the door or \$40 for 10. \$2.50/guest after 5pm daily. Children age two (2) and under are free.
4. If a member writes a bad check for initiation or membership, privileges are immediately revoked until full payment is received. If a member with a valid membership writes a bad check for a party or other social event, a member will have 7 days to make good or the family's pool membership is revoked until full payment is received. Private Party assessment charge for clean up must be paid within 7 days or the family's pool membership is revoked until full payment is received.
5. No pets allowed in the REC CLUB area.
6. Please observe the following health and safety rules in the use of the pool and grounds:
 - a. All persons shall use the pool and facilities at their own risk.
 - b. ALL CHILDREN under eight (8) years of age and CHILDREN ages eight (8) through 12, inclusive, who have NOT passed the swimming test, shall NOT be admitted to the pool unless supervised by a Member 13 years or older or



with a sitter with a membership provided by the parents. The swim test shall consist of swimming twice the length of the pool and thereafter treading water two minutes before touching the side of the pool. The Lifeguards shall administer the swim test.

- c. Baby-sitters will be allowed to watch all children eight (8) years old and under and children ages eight (8) through 12 years old, inclusive, who have not passed the swim test under the following circumstances:
 - 1. Baby-sitters must be a current REC CLUB Member, be part of the baby-sitter plan, or have paid the daily guest fee.
 - 2. Baby-sitter must be at least 13 years old.
 - 3. The Pool Staff in charge has the authority to determine the qualifications of the baby-sitter. If the baby-sitter, in the Pool Staff's judgment, does not responsibly take care of the child(ren), the Pool Staff shall instruct the sitter to leave the pool area with the child(ren).
 - 4. Baby-sitters will sign in at the desk with their names, the child(ren)'s name(s) and an emergency phone number of where the parents may be reached. If they are not in possession of this information, they will not be admitted.
 - d. The Pool Staff has the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's foot, any infectious disorders, or persons wearing bandages.
 - e. The Pool Staff may request any person take reasonable rest periods to avoid fatigue and/or over exposure.
 - f. Showers should be used before entering the pool.
 - g. Only children FIVE YEARS of age and under may use the wading pool. **There is not a lifeguard assigned to the wading pool area.** Parents are solely responsible for their child(ren)'s safety.
 - h. Parents are responsible and must watch their child(ren) in **all** areas of the pool complex
7. No person shall talk to or otherwise distract the attention of the lifeguards unless there is an emergency. Any comments or suggestions should be directed to the Pool Manager – not the lifeguards.
8. The pool hours for the season will be Monday through Sunday 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. (Fridays & Saturdays until 9:00 p.m), weather permitting.
- a. Adult Swim Nights may be held periodically on Friday/Saturday evenings. Dates for these swim nights will be posted in advance. Children will not be permitted to enter the grounds on these nights.



- b. There will also be special activity during the afternoon and evenings that will be announced in advance.
 - c. The pool may be closed periodically for the swim team for Meets, Practices, Time Trials etc. Proper notice will be given.
9. The term "Adult" when referred to in these rules and regulations shall mean any person 21 years of age or older.
10. A \$.25 fee will be charged to make a phone call. Do not use the phone when wet. The phone is available at no charge for all EMERGENCY CALLS.
11. The following rules shall be observed at all times:
- a. DIVING FROM THE POOL'S EDGE IS PROHIBITED. The Pool Staff has the authority to remove swimmers that dive off the side of the pool.
 - b. Only ONE person at a time shall be allowed on the diving board.
 - c. No person may dive until the previous diver has reached the ladder or cleared the diving well.
 - d. Excessive bouncing on the board is prohibited.
 - e. Swimmers shall enter the diving area only from the diving board unless the Pool Staff on duty closes the diving board.
 - f. Games and/or clowning are not permitted in the diving area. Failure to comply could constitute expulsion from the pool.
 - g. Divers shall go off the diving board in a standing position and use the board in a responsible manner.
12. Federal law prohibits attire other than a regular bathing suit.
13. No person shall push, run, shove, towel snap or annoy other persons using the pool facilities.
14. No person shall engage in indecent or offensive conduct or use profane or vulgar language.
15. No glass containers of any kind shall be allowed on the grounds. This includes baby bottles.



16. Food, beverages, and refreshments shall be consumed only on the deck and grass areas. No food, drink or gum is allowed in either pool. All refuse is to be deposited in the appropriate receptacles provided.
17. Beach balls, Nerf balls and inner tubes will be allowed in the pool and grass areas at the discretion of the Pool Staff. They must be used in a responsible manner and kept away from the sides of the pool.
18. Smokers are asked to use the proper receptacles. No smoking permitted in any building on the pool grounds.
19. The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible Member, including the damage caused by guests of such Member. This includes any malicious damage to the soda machine, furniture or any other property on the REC CLUB grounds. You and your family's privileges are immediately revoked until full payment is resolved.
20. The REC CLUB management SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for any accident, injury, theft or so-called loss or damage to personal property on the club premises. All found items are placed in the lost and found box for your retrieval.
21. All non-swimmers shall remain on the shallow side of the lifeline. Persons are requested not to hang on the rope. Swimmers are encouraged to stay on the deeper side of the line.
22. Activities that infringe the enjoyment and safety of others are prohibited.
23. All individuals in the recreational area must obey the Pool Staff on duty in all matters regarding the use of the pool and other facilities.
24. Latex Balloons in the pool facility is strictly prohibited.
25. BASKETBALL, TENNIS COURT, ACTIVITY CENTER (previously the Skate Park), PARKING AREAS AND PICNIC AREAS:
 - a. Pool Staff will check these areas for membership and guest use regularly. Any one not possessing current membership will be asked to leave.
26. TENNIS RULES
 - a. Only club Members in good standing and their guests are permitted to use



- the courts.
- b. Climbing on or over any fencing is PROHIBITED.
 - c. Members are asked to LOCK THE COURTS when they leave if no other Members are using the courts.
 - d. No activities other than tennis are permitted. This includes no bicycling, skateboarding or rollerblading on the courts.
 - e. Tennis shoes (white soles are preferred) must be worn on the courts. No other type of shoe will be permitted.
 - f. When other players are waiting, players currently on the courts will relinquish the courts after one hour or two sets whichever come FIRST.
 - g. Adults have preference to court time on weekends and holidays.
 - h. All refuse is to be deposited in the appropriate receptacles provided.
 - i. If leaves and other debris are on the playing area of the courts, tennis players are requested to sweep the debris off the courts with the broom provided.
 - j. All are expected to provide their own equipment.

The Pool Staff and/or REC CLUB Management is charged with the interpretation and enforcement of the foregoing Rules and Regulations and is hereby authorized to suspend or reject any person violating the same. The Pool Manager and Board of Directors shall determine the duration of such suspension. Successive violations may be considered sufficient cause for cancellation of membership. No portion of membership or initiation fee shall be refunded. These rules and regulations have been established for the protection of all Members and their guests. This is your pool and no set of rules can be any more effective than your adherence to them.

The Pool Staff may initiate penalties for any offenses committed, ranging from time out, and picking up trash/debris to expulsion for the day from the Pool Complex.

Any objectionable activities or items not covered in these Rules and Regulations will be judged by the Pool Manager and Board of Directors.

The Pool Staff has the right to change the schedule or close the pool at any time. The Rec Club Management reserves the right to amend these Rules and Regulations at any time without prior notice.

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
